QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

- 2. What makes people turn to prayer in difficult times?
- 3. Have you ever experienced a situation like Lesley?
- 4. Did you get your green rubber band? What was it?
- 5. Do you think it's possible to miss the green rubber bands God might be sending you in answer to your prayers? Why or why not?
- 6. God's answer wasn't to send a magic helicopter to pick up her brother. He didn't change anything about her situation at all. Why was his rubber band enough for her? What did it mean?
- 7. How did Lesley respond to her answered prayer?
- 8. How would you have responded?
- 9. What can you do to better recognize when God answers your prayers?
